National Education Union Industrial Action

5th and 7th July 2023

Dear parents/carers,

The next round of industrial action is planned to be for two days on the 5th and 7th July 2023. After speaking to staff and with supply agencies, I again cannot cover all affected classes due to the very high levels of demand and many supply teachers refusing to cover striking teachers on that day.

On 5th July, Red and Verde classes will be closed

On 7th July, Rainbow (Nursery), Red, Blue, Yellow and Verde classes will be closed

All other classes will remain open as normal on the two days.

Legally, I am not allowed to ask striking teachers to set or mark work for the days they are striking so there will be no online provision for the affected classes.

Lime Trees before and after school provision will be in place for those children who are attending school (including vulnerable and key worker children).

As I have said in my previous letters, staff are also legally entitled to change their mind right up to the date of the industrial action. If this happens, we may have to change arrangements at the last minute and I'd like to apologise in advance if this occurs but it is not in my control.

Thank you for your support and patience and I am sorry for the disruption to the children affected.
