

## **Holiday forms/leave of absence lead-time reminder**

A friendly reminder that all leave of absence requests should be sent to the office at least 4 weeks before the absence is taken. This allows the school time to process the request and for parents to provide evidence.

Should your child be absent for a reason which we cannot authorise, we would still appreciate honesty and being informed. Unfortunately, we have had some instances of parents asking their children to be dishonest about their absence – including being told they are going for medical appointments or that the child is ill and children then tell us this is not the case. It is important that there is honesty and respect between home and school and that your child is not put in a difficult position with trusted adults and friends. If the school suspects a holiday is taken, we will mark the absence as unauthorised and a penalty notice may be pursued.
